San Diego County Innovation Plan

Summary: The Mental Health Services Oversight and Accountability Commission (MHSOAC or Commission) will consider approval of San Diego County's request to expand its previously approved Innovative (INN) project, Faith-Based Initiative. Staff reviewed the county's plan and recommends that the Commission approve an augmentation of \$1,009,203 to bring the project to a revised total of \$2,504,778 for three years.

The Commission initially approved the Faith-Based initiative project on February 26, 2015 to serve two regions in the County. Due to County procurement processes, program implementation has been delayed. It is due to start March 1, 2016. San Diego County is requesting an addition of \$1,009,203 to expand the program and allow for implementation of Crisis Response and Wellness & Ministry components in the North Inland region.

San Diego County is requesting authorization from the MHSOAC to expand the Innovation funding for this three-year project by \$1,009,203 bringing the total amount to \$2,504,778.
